



KAK Industry – Machine Operator

A Machine Operator for the KAK Industry Albany Missouri facility is responsible operating and maintaining the machine or machining cell to which they are assigned. The Machine Operator reports directly to the Manufacturing Manager and may be responsible for other employees. The Machine Operator is capable of carrying out all basic functions listed below and is expected to learn more advanced skills through additional training. Machine Operator is a full-time hourly position with overtime available. All standard company benefits apply.

General Responsibilities:

- Familiarity with all company policies and practices.
- Management of all assigned employees
- Basic operation of the assigned machine or machine cell including but not limited to
 - Daily and scheduled maintenance
 - Tool Changes
 - Minor programming adjustments such as offset correction
 - Resetting automation when needed
 - Routine machine safety and status checks
- Ensuring consistent production through established quality control procedures
- Maintain an organized and clean work area
- Supervise and train assigned assistants

Requirements

- Ability to read and understand technical drawings
- Ability to lift and move 50 pounds
- Able to stand for the majority of a 10 hour shift
- Ability to use basic hand tools
- Working knowledge of basic metrology instruments

Work Week

- Rotating 10 hour shift – 4 days on, 2 days off, 3 days on, 3 days off
- Shifts are 5:00am to 3:30pm and 3:00pm to 1:30am
- Overtime may be required on occasion
- All times may be adjusted based on need
